### Short biography:

He was born on December 5, 1950 in the Khabarovsk Region. In 1973 he graduated from the East Faculty of the Far Eastern State University (FENU), by specialty "History of Japan, Japanese Language". In 1973, he joined the Institute of History, Archeology and Ethnography of the Peoples of the Far East, where he currently works. In 1988 he defended his dissertation .

Since 1996, associate professor of the Eastern Faculty of FENU (part-time).

2002-2004 - visiting professor Niigata Sangyo University (Kashiwazaki, Japan).

Since 2004, Professor of the Oriental Faculty. (in combination, since 2012 - FEFU)

Since 2015 he is a leading researcher at the Institute.

He regularly took part and delivered reports at regional, all-Russian, international (including abroad) scientific conferences. He was the head of four graduate students who have successfully defended their dissertations for a Ph.D. (from 2007 to 2012), including one person of Japan) a participant of collective grants of the Far Eastern Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences. Responsible editor of five scientific collections on the materials of Russian-Japanese symposia, the author of nine monographs and textbooks (one of them in co-authorship). The total number of publications is 150.
