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### Academic career

From 1996 to 2001, I studied international relations at the Far Eastern State Technical University in Vladivostok.

From 2001 to 2004, I was a postgraduate student and an Academic Assistant at the Department of Philosophy at the same University.

From 2004 to 2009, I was a DAAD postgraduate research fellow at the University of Frankfurt (Germany) and then a postgraduate research fellow and a free student at the Universities of Frankfurt and Marburg.

From 2009 to 2011, I was an Assistant Professor at the Department of Philosophy at the Far Eastern State Technical University (in 2011 it was integrated into the newly founded Far Eastern Federal University in Vladivostok), from 2011 to 2107 an Associate Professor. I held lectures and seminars in theoretical philosophy, history of philosophy, philosophy of religion, ethics, and modern logic for undergraduate students.

In 2010, I defended my thesis in the history of philosophy at the Herzen State Pedagogical University of Russia in Saint Petersburg.

Since 2014, I am employed on a permanent basis as an Associate Professor at the Department of Philosophy at the Institute of History, Archaeology, and Ethnography of the Peoples of the Far East (a constituent institution of the Far East Branch of the Russian Academy of Science) in Vladivostok. Together with the Department Chair Andrey Popovkin I give an annual lecture course «History and philosophy of science and technics» for postgraduate students of the Far East Branch of the Russian Academy of Science.

In 2014, I was awarded a DAAD research grant once again and spent 10 months as a postgraduate research fellow at the Department of Analytic Philosophy and Theory of Science at the University of Augsburg (Germany) under the supervision of Professor Uwe Meixner.
